Chief Judge Joel Gerber of the United States Tax Court announced that the written examination for admission to practice for applicants other than attorneys at law will be held at 12:15 p.m. on Thursday, November 9, 2006, at the United States Tax Court Building, 400 Second Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20217. This announcement is the notice required by Tax Court Rule 200(a)(3).

The Chief Judge further announced that the examination will consist of the following subjects and that those subjects shall be accorded the percentage weight indicated in parenthesis:

- A. Tax Court Rules of Practice and Procedure (25%);
- B. Federal taxation (40%);
- C. Federal Rules of Evidence (25%);
- D. Legal ethics, including the ABA Model Rules of Professional Conduct (10%).

Applicants may obtain copies of the most recent examinations from the Tax Court for a fee of \$.50 per page, payable to the Clerk, U.S. Tax Court. The Tax Court Rules of Practice and Procedure are available for \$22.00 per copy from the Tax Court's Administrative Office at 400 Second Street, N.W., Room 111, Washington, D.C. 20217. The check or money order should be made payable to the Clerk, U.S. Tax Court. The Tax Court Rules are also available on the Tax Court's official web site at www.ustaxcourt.gov.

The Court will begin accepting applications on June 1, 2006, and all applications must be received properly completed no later than October 2, 2006.
