## PRESS RELEASE

Chief Judge Kathleen Kerrigan announced today that Jennifer E. Siegel and Zachary S. Fried have been selected to serve as Special Trial Judges of the United States Tax Court.

Ms. Siegel started at the Tax Court in 2006 as Attorney-Adviser to Special Trial Judge Robert N. Armen, Jr. She has also served as an Assistant Deputy Counsel to the Chief Judge, the Deputy Clerk of the Court, and since 2019, the Court's Public Affairs Counsel.

Ms. Siegel holds a B.A. from Barnard College, an M.B.A. from the Drucker School of Management at Claremont Graduate University, a J.D. from the University of San Francisco School of Law, and an LL.M. in Taxation from New York University School of Law. Ms. Siegel will take the oath of office on September 11, 2023.

Mr. Fried started at the Tax Court in 2009 as Attorney-Adviser to Chief Special Trial Judge Lewis R. Carluzzo. Most recently, Mr. Fried has been serving as the Court's Deputy Counsel. Prior to his time with the Court, Mr. Fried worked for the Apartment and Office Building Association of Metropolitan Washington as an attorney.

Mr. Fried holds a B.A. from the University of Virginia, a J.D. from the George Washington University Law School, and an LL.M. in Taxation from the Georgetown University Law Center. Mr. Fried will take the oath of office on October 10, 2023.
