ORDER

The Court has received reports from all parties. We agree with respondent's statement that, barring stipulation between the parties, these cases will probably require a trial. ORDERED that all proceedings herein are stayed pending further information regarding her release date from incarceration, in that, the parties are to submit on or before December 1, 2014, joint or separate status reports as to the then present status of the above cases. It is further

ORDERED that the above cases are restored to the general docket and are no longer jurisdiction retained by the undersigned.
