ORDER

This complex case was on the Court's December 10, 2007 trial calendar for Miami, Florida, and stems from the death of Mr. Boulis back in 2001. Related cases sprawled over two continents and several different courts, but the last pieces were several peripheral issues in the probate proceeding that remained on appeal in the state-court system until last year. The final state-court issues are about fees appropriately charged to the estate during this *Jarndyce v. Jarndyce* - like litigation. The parties report mediation ongoing. If this mediation succeeds in producing a settlement, it remains likely that the liquidation of administrative expenses will be the last remaining chores in this long-running case. The case can stay on a long-term status-report track, and it is

ORDERED that on or before February 12, 2018 the parties submit settlement documents or file a status report describing their efforts to settle the case or narrow the issues to be tried.
