ORDER

This case was scheduled to be tried at the Court's Washington, D.C., session beginning October 16, 2017. At the telephonic request of petitioner Aboubacar Camara--who stated that he was was out of the country, that he could not timely reenter because he had lost his travel documents, and that he would contact respondent when he returned, in order to prepare this case for trial--the Court continued the case and ordered the filing of a status report by November 22, 2017. On that date respondent filed a status report, in which he reported that he learned by telephone from petitioner Fanta Cisse that Mr. Camara has not returned to the United States, and that Ms. Cisse is unaware of when he intends to return or whether he has resolved the problem with his travel papers. It is therefore

ORDERED that the undersigned judge no longer retains jurisdiction over this case, and that the case is continued generally, to be tried at a future session of the Court in Washington, D.C. Petitioners should not expect any further continuance of this case but should instead promptly communicate with respondent to prepare the case for trial, should attend carefully to future orders of the Court,
