ORDER

On June 13, 2018, Thomas J. Sawyer of the U.S. Department of Justice (Justice Department) filed a Motion For Admission of Counsel Pro Hac Vice, a Motion For Leave to File in Paper Form, and a Statement of Interest With Respect to the Court’s Order of November 15, 2017, Permitting Contemporaneous Trial Testimony From Berlin, Germany. Mr. Sawyer states that the parties in this action do not object to his motions for admission of counsel pro hac vice and for leave to file in paper form.

Writing on behalf of the Justice Department in the Statement of Interest, Mr. Sawyer asks the Court to reconsider our November 15, 2017, Order in which we granted petitioners’ Motion to Permit Witness Testimony of Jonathan Zuhovitzky and Esther Zuhovitzky by Contemporaneous Transmission from a Different Location. Upon due consideration, it is

ORDERED that Mr. Sawyer’s Motion for Admission of Counsel Pro Hac Vice is granted. It is further

ORDERED that Mr. Sawyer’s Motion for Leave to File in Paper Form is granted. It is further

ORDERED that petitioners shall file a Response to the Statement of Interest on or before July 11, 2018. Petitioners' response should include a certificate of service affirming that they served Mr. Sawyer with their response. It is further

ORDERED that, in addition to regular service, the Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this Order on Thomas Sawyer, Tax Division, U.S. Department of Justice, P.O. Box 683, Ben Franklin Station, Washington, DC 20044.
