ORDER

Siewert is severed as a petitioner from the case at Docket No. 24680-13 and is assigned Docket No. 22878-15, bearing the caption “Theresa M. Siewert, v. Commissioner of Internal Revenue, Respondent.” The proceedings in this case will be held in abeyance with respect to her. It is also

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall place a copy of the petition, answer and reply filed in docket number 24680-13 as the petition, answer and reply at docket number 22878-15. The Clerk of the Court shall file a copy of this order in docket number 22878-15. It is also

ORDERED that the filing fee at docket number 22878-15 is waived. It is also

ORDERED that St. Paul, Minnesota is designated as the place of trial for docket number 22878-15. It is also

ORDERED that the caption of the case at docket number 24680-13 is amended to read: "Jeffrey A. Siewert, Petitioner, v. Commissioner of Internal Revenue, Respondent." It is also

ORDERED that the division of this Court retains jurisdiction for docket number 22878-15. It is also

ORDERED that Thomas Edward Brever is considered counsel of record at docket no. 22878-15.
