ORDER

By order dated April 27, 2020, the Court canceled the Special Trial Session scheduled to begin on September 14, 2020, in New York, New York, and struck these cases from that calendar. After having consulted with the parties, the Court will schedule the above cases for trial at a Special Trial Session commencing on Tuesday, October 13, 2020. Due to ongoing public health and safety concerns about COVID-19, on June 24, 2020, the parties agreed to a remote trial proceeding. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that these cases are set for trial at a remote Special Trial Session scheduled to commence on Tuesday, October 13, 2020, at 10:00 AM (Eastern Time). It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall issue a Notice of Remote Proceeding to the parties that shall contain comprehensive instructions on how to participate in the above-referenced remote proceeding. It is further

ORDERED that on or before September 29, 2020, the parties shall file a joint stipulation of facts and lodge the exhibits they intend to use at trial. It is further

ORDERED that the dates referenced below amend so much of the Court's December 10, 2019, standing pretrial schedule:

(F)	August 28, 2020	Last day to exchange materials relied upon by the rebuttal expert in the preparation of his or her report.

(H)	August 28, 2020	Last day to file any necessary motions to compel stipulation.
(I)	September 23, 2020	Mail pre-trial memoranda to the Court and to the opposing party.
(J)	September 25, 2020	Identify and exchange documents to be offered into evidence that are not stipulated.
(K)	September 25, 2020	Last day to file motions in limine.
