ORDER

This collection due process (CDP) case is calendared on the Court’s October 22, 2018, Washington, D.C., trial session. On November 8, 2017, the IRS sent petitioner a Final Notice of Intent to Levy and Your Right to a Hearing and petitioner timely requested a CDP hearing. On September 7, 2018, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Remand asking that the case be sent back to the IRS Office of Appeals for a supplemental CDP hearing. Upon due consideration, it is

ORDERED that the parties’ Joint Motion to Remand, filed September 7, 2018, is granted, and this case is remanded to the IRS Office of Appeals for a supplemental CDP hearing. It is further

ORDERED that this case is stricken from the Court’s October 22, 2018, Washington, D.C., trial session. It is further

ORDERED that respondent shall offer petitioner a supplemental administrative hearing at a reasonable and mutually agreeable date and time, but no later than January 12, 2019. It is further

ORDERED that the undersigned will retain jurisdiction of this case. It is further

ORDERED that respondent shall file with the Court, on or before February 12, 2019, a report detailing the then-present status of the case. It is further

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ORDERED that, if and when any supplemental notice of determination is issued to petitioner, respondent at that time shall file a status report and attach thereto a copy of the supplemental notice of determination.
