ORDER

This “collection due process” (“CDP”) case was scheduled to be tried at the Court’s session in Detroit, Michigan, commencing September 18, 2017. On July 25, 2017 (in response to our order of July 20, 2017), the IRS filed a motion to remand, in which it asks the Court to remand the case to the IRS’s Office Appeals for further consideration in that office. It is therefore

ORDERED that this case is stricken from the trial calendar commencing September 18, 2017, in Detroit, Michigan. Petitioner Leroy M. Jaggars is advised that this case will not be called at, and that he need not attend, the Detroit session on September 18, 2017. It is further

ORDERED that jurisdiction is retained by the undersigned judge. It is further

ORDERED that the IRS’s motion to remand is granted, and this case is remanded to the IRS’s Office of Appeals for the purpose of affording petitioner a supplemental administrative hearing. It is further

ORDERED that the IRS shall offer petitioner a supplemental hearing at the IRS’s Appeals Office located closest to petitioner’s residence (or at such other

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place as may be mutually agreed upon) at a reasonable and mutually agreed upon date and time, but no later than October 25, 2017. It is further

ORDERED that the parties shall, on or before November 27, 2017, file with the Court a joint report (or, if that is not expedient, then separate reports), explaining the status of the case and proposing a schedule for further proceedings.
