ORDER

This collection due process (CDP) case is calendared on the Court's October 22, 2018, Washington, D.C., trial session. On August 20, 2018, respondent filed a Motion to Remand asking that the case be sent back to the IRS Office of Appeals for further consideration. By order dated August 24, 2018, petitioners were directed to file a response to respondent's motion on or before September 17, 2018. Petitioners did not respond to that order. Upon due consideration, it is

ORDERED that respondent's Motion to Remand, filed August 20, 2018, is granted, and this case is remanded to the IRS Office of Appeals for further consideration. It is further

ORDERED that respondent shall offer petitioners a supplemental administrative hearing at a reasonable and mutually agreeable date and time, but no later than January 29, 2019. It is further

ORDERED that the undersigned will retain jurisdiction of this case. It is further

ORDERED that respondent shall file with the Court, on or before March 1, 2019, a report detailing the then-present status of the case. It is further

ORDERED that, if and when any supplemental notice of determination is issued to petitioners, respondent at that time shall file a status report and attach thereto a copy of the supplemental notice of determination.
