ORDER

Complainant seeks review by the Judicial Conduct and Disability Council of a complaint of judicial conduct. Upon due consideration of the record, it is unanimously

ORDERED that complainant's petition is denied for the reasons stated in the June 1, 2017, Order signed by the Chief Judge and the memorandum attached thereto.

In the Petition for Review complainant asserts that the June 1, 2017 Order did not fairly address his complaint. We disagree. Complainant asserts that his complaint is not limited to the conduct of an individual judge and instead concerns the Court's interpretation and application in many cases of the word "verification" in 26 U.S.C. sec. 6330(c)(1). No matter how many cases in which the Court applies a legal interpretation with which complainant disagrees, his objection to that interpretation is "merits related" and therefore not cognizable under the Court's Judicial Conduct and Disability procedures.
